Blood, dirt, flies, thirst, hunger, pain, death and terror amid the Sri Lanka military's relentless shelling.

Over 300,000 people surrounded in an area the size of Central Park, then starved and bombarded.

The wounded lay amongst the dead in the open compounds that served as 'hospitals' in the final weeks of the war.
