Shavendra Silva, has said that some diaspora Tamils are spreading false propaganda against the army, during his visit to Jaffna yesterday.

He highlighted the help that the Sri Lankan army does for the Tamil community and noted the house provided for a woman who lost her husband in the armed conflict.

"The Sri Lanka Army has not only provided the house but also all the necessities for the house including a refrigerator and provided financial assistance, school equipment for a student in the family and we are ready to assist the student in further educational activities."

Today we are visiting Jaffna District to enquire about the current security situation in Jaffna as well as the COVID-19 outlook. In the coming days I will evaluate the issues pertaining to COVID-19 and how to manage it. With the upcoming Sinhala and Tamil new year, I urge the public to celebrate in a peaceful manner."
